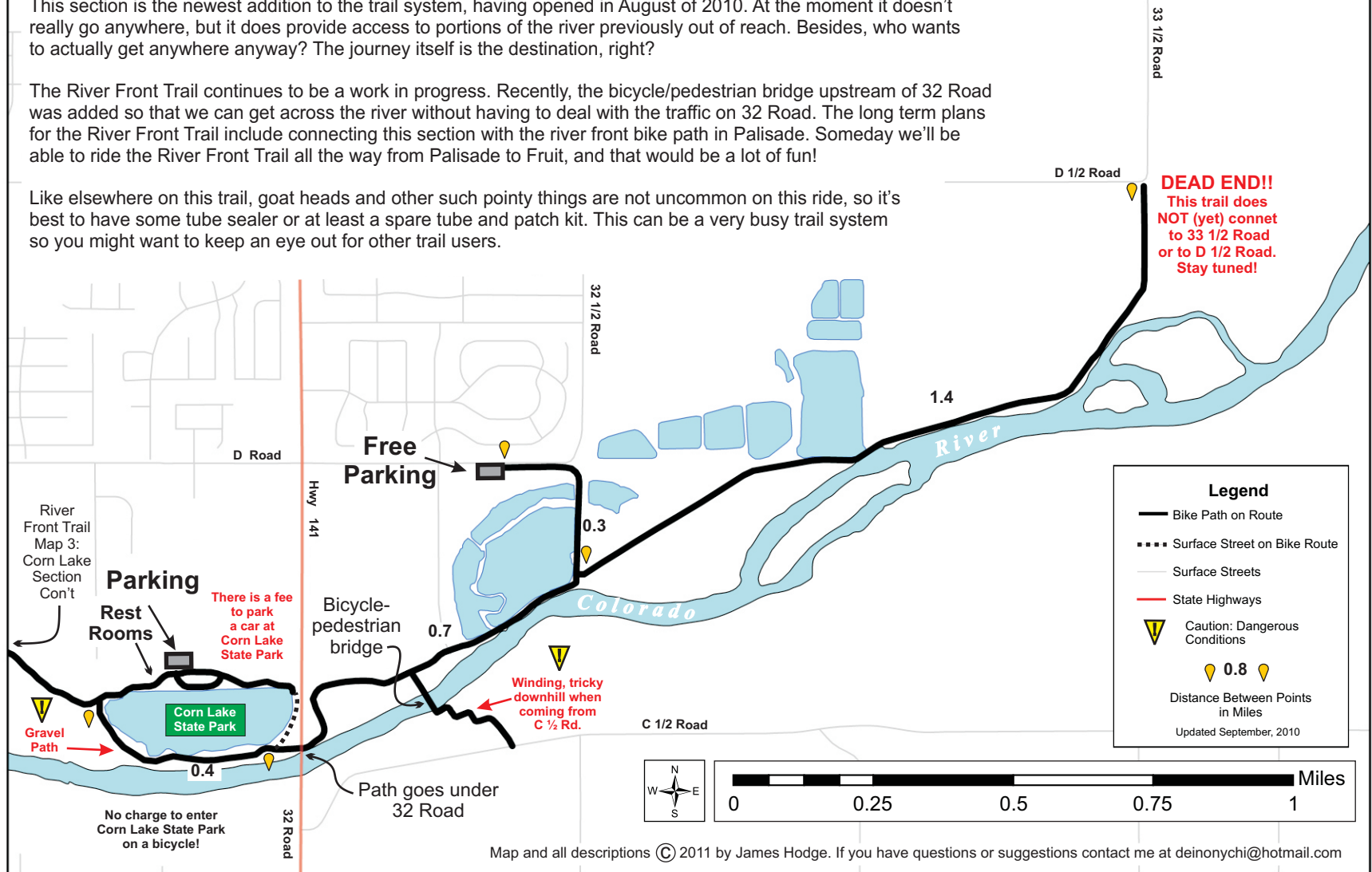


River Front Trail Map 4: Clifton Section

This section is the newest addition to the trail system, having opened in August of 2010. At the moment it doesn't really go anywhere, but it does provide access to portions of the river previously out of reach. Besides, who wants to actually get anywhere anyway? The journey itself is the destination, right?

The River Front Trail continues to be a work in progress. Recently, the bicycle/pedestrian bridge upstream of 32 Road was added so that we can get across the river without having to deal with the traffic on 32 Road. The long term plans for the River Front Trail include connecting this section with the river front bike path in Palisade. Someday we'll be able to ride the River Front Trail all the way from Palisade to Fruit, and that would be a lot of fun!

Like elsewhere on this trail, goat heads and other such pointy things are not uncommon on this ride, so it's best to have some tube sealer or at least a spare tube and patch kit. This can be a very busy trail system so you might want to keep an eye out for other trail users.
