




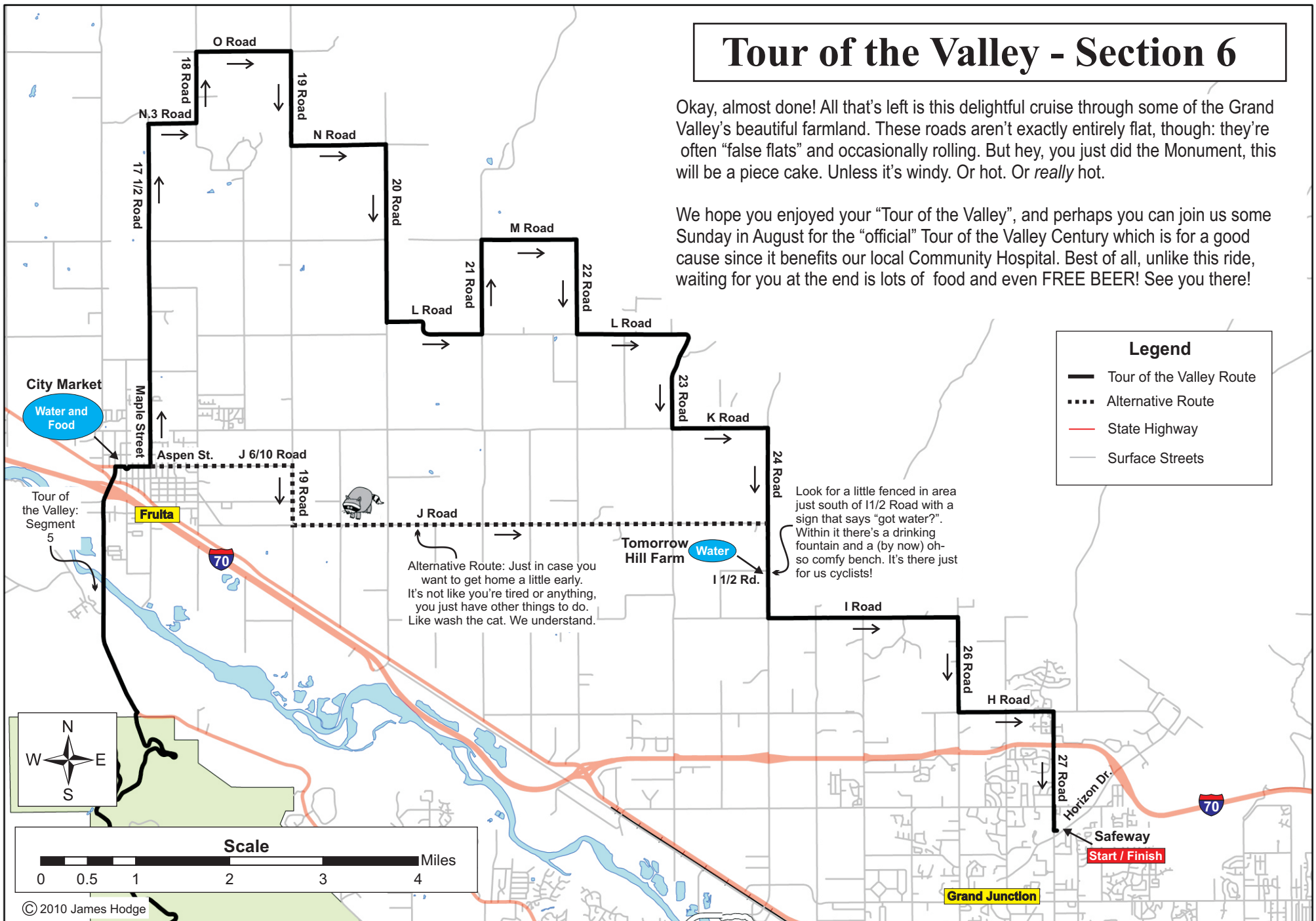
Tour of the Valley - Section 6
